## **Programme**

### **Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> June**

**10.00: Registration and official opening** - Scouts teams arrive in full uniform with all required camping and cooking equipment. Teams will be allocated camping and cooking area.

**10.30 to 12.00: Set up camp and cooking area.**

**12.00 to 13.30: Prepare and Cook a simple lunch.** This only needs to be one course. (During this session the team will choose one member to be interviewed by the 'Prances got talent team' for the 'Can't cook /Won't cook' session)

**13.30 to 14.30: lunch** will be served with a portion set up for the judges. The team member chosen for 14.30 session will be interviewed while team clear up from lunch.

**14.30 to 16.30: 'Can't cook' 'Won't cook'** session will begin in the hall. This will be a **cook off** between two selected team members and will be guided by a professional chef. The District will provide the equipment and ingredients for this activity. Everyone to be in hall for this.

**16.30 to 19.45: Prepare and Cook dinner (evening meal),** make a camp gadget and prepare a skit or song for the campfire. Meal to be served at 19.00 (make a portion for the judging) clear up.

**19.45 to 20.15: Official inspection of campsites** for the camp competition followed by flag down.

**20.15 to 21.30: Campfire**

**21.30: Hot drink and snack** provided by HQ with a fun quiz

**22.15: Final tidy up** and lights out.

**Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> June**

**07.00 to 08.30: Cook breakfast** and clear away (not part of competition)

**08.30 to 09.30: flag break** and scouts own

**09.30 to 11.00: activities** provided by HQ

**11.00 to 12.30: clear away**, pack away and break camp

**12.30 to 13.00. Gather** at the flag for results, presentations and flag break. (Parents may be present for this. If not scouts will be able to leave camp from 13.00 please sign out with organizers)
