

# Maldon and East Essex District Scout Camp

## Rules

1. **This district camp** is designed to be a **fun filled** cooking and camping competition. The cooking competition will be for the District 'master chef' cup and the camping for the Leslie cup.
2. The **law** of the camp will be the scout law.
3. **Teams of 3 to 6** (if you have only one scout that wants to join in or you can't make a team, still enter as I will find them you a team for the weekend)
4. **The fee will be £5.00** per head and this will cover 'can't cook won't cook', the activities, camp fees, supper, any awards and any other camp requirements.
5. **Teams** must provide their own food for the weekend according to their menus. All food must be made from scratch at camp. This will not be included in camp fees. Menus must be submitted to judges by 10.30 on Sat morning. Teams must cook a **simple lunch of one course**. **Dinner** must be **two course meal** either a main and dessert or starter and main. Teams will not be judged on breakfast.
6. Any means of **camp cooking** can be used e.g. camp oven, gas, wood fire's, barbeque. All equipment needed must be brought to camp by the teams and will not be allowed to add to it during the weekend. Only kit and food carried on at start of camp will be allowed.
7. Teams must **make a camp gadget** (you may bring all the bamboo/wood and string for it, or use wood on site; whichever is chosen none of the gadgets must be prefabricated. It must all be constructed on site. **Gadgets** will be judged after dinner when camp is inspected.
8. Teams must prepare a **skit or song for the campfire** this can be pre prepared in a Scout meeting and practiced at camp or can be made up at the camp. It must be at least two minutes long and points will be awarded for performance, suitability and involvement of whole team.
9. **Judges** will give teams points (points will be agreed with judges and shared with teams by 10.30 on the Sat) during the day for camp skills such as gadget making, use of bonafide scout camping techniques, thoughts for how to preserve the environment e.g. wet and dry pits, litter collection etc. general cleanliness and neatness of tents and camp kitchen. High level of safety at all times.
10. **Judges** interpretation of the rules is at their discretion and their decision will be **final**
11. **All scouts must arrive and depart in Full Uniform** however camp clothes are appropriate for camp itself.
12. **The ADC Scouts and ADC Entertainment are jointly in charge of the running of this camp and will reserve the right to adapt the rules and the camp programme where they deem it appropriate.**
